Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I receive access to the classes?

A: A Zoom link and meeting code will be sent to the e-mail address that was used to register you for the class.

Q: If I am not able to watch the program live, will I be able to access it later?

A: Yes, the programs will be recorded and may be accessed for full credit afterwards. If you miss a class, you will need to contact Emily at emily@mnla.org in order to view the recording and receive your allotted credits.

Q: What platform is being used? Do I need an account?

A: All classes will be held virtually via Zoom, and no account is needed.

Q: What technological capabilities will I need?

A: You will need a strong internet connection, and either audio or video capabilities in order to confirm your attendance. The program may be viewed on a phone, tablet, or laptop.

Q: How do I submit my Applicator number?

A: Say goodbye to bubble sheets! At the end of the class, you will submit your applicator number and contact information to the host via an online link. You will then receive the seminar code for the session.

Q: How will I get credits?

A: Each 4-hour class is worth 4 credits in Core (Priv. & Comm.), 2, 3A, 3B, 5, 6, 7A, or 7F. You will elect which category you would like to add your credits to when you complete the online form at the end of each seminar.

Q: How do I know how many credits I need?

A: You will need to contact the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD) at 800-292-3939. This number is also listed on the back of your pesticide applicator license.

Q: What if I need tech support during the classes?
